



## Government Funded Transition Summer Schools

We ran two successful transition summer schools for our incoming Year 7 students. These were made possible this year through additional government support.

We had a week that took place at the start of the school summer holidays (26 to 30 July 2021) and then one for our SEND and Pupil Premium students only, which took place at the end of the summer (23 to 27 Aug 2021). This allowed them to settle in, and become familiar with the school in a much quieter and calmer environment.

Throughout both of the weeks, the students were able to:

- Get to know members of staff
- Get to know others in their year group and their own form
- Enable our support staff to get to know students
- Familiarise themselves with the large school building
- Have the opportunity to use the school canteen
- Carry out team building and problem-solving activities
